



## ATHLETIC REFERENCE GUIDE: VOLLEYBALL

Student participation in extracurricular activities benefits students academically, socially, physically, and emotionally. The Legacy Junior High School administration supports our students and coaches in their efforts to grow and learn through extracurricular activities. Legacy administration accepts the rights and responsibility to set academic and behavioral standards for student athletes. Additionally, individuals shall not be denied an opportunity to try-out for athletic teams based on their race, color, religion, national origin, sex, or disability.

### Who is the 2023-2024 LJH volleyball coach?

### What are the eligibility requirements?

Students must have at least a 2.0 GPA in 4<sup>th</sup> term of the previous year to tryout. Students cannot have more than one “F”. Incompletes in Summit are considered an “F”. If a student received one “U” 4<sup>th</sup> term, students must apply to the School Athletic Standards Committee for participation. Students with more than one “U” 4<sup>th</sup> term are ineligible to participate.

### Is there a volleyball camp before tryouts?

There is an open gym, with minimal coaching, from Aug 14 – Aug 18 in the Legacy Jr. gym from 3:15 – 5:00. There is no fee for the open gym. Anyone can come, play, and work on skills.

### When is LJH volleyball tryout?

Tryouts will be on Aug. 21 at 3:15 pm in the Legacy gym. Pre-registration for tryouts is required and can be completed at “Aktivate.com”. To tryout, a UHSSA physical must be uploaded to the website the day before tryouts. Family members or other visitors are not allowed to be present during tryouts. Coach Wallis will select players for the LJH volleyball team, and her decision will be final.

### What are the fees associated with being selected to play on the volleyball team?

The Davis School District fee schedule allows for the following fees. Approved fundraisers may be held to cover additional costs. Fee waiver applications may be found [HERE](#).

### When are the volleyball games?

The game schedule can be found on the school and school district website. There will usually be two games a week. Games will start at 3:15.

### What are the expected behaviors for students selected for the LJH volleyball team?

Participation in athletics is not a constitutionally protected right. It is expected that students conduct themselves in a manner that benefits the image of the school. Students who participate in hazing, bullying, profane language, drug use, improper touching, or excessive school disruption will be removed from the team. Less egregious behavior may result in probation and review by the Standards Committee.

### What are the LJH expectations of parents?

Legacy invites parents to be supportive of the team by attending home and away games, ensuring student attendance at practices, and reinforcing student academic expectations. Parents may not attend practice. Parents are expected to be positive during games and may be removed or barred from games for negative language or abusive comments to the opposing team, referees, coaches, administration, or other attendees.
